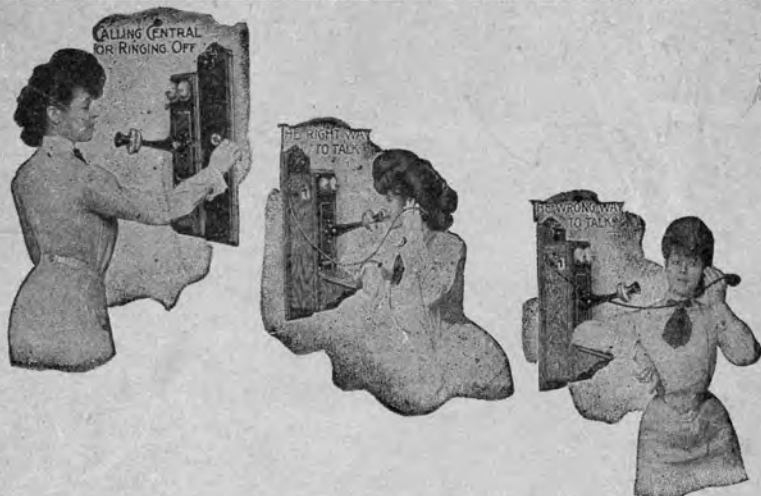

## SUGGESTIONS TO SUBSCRIBERS

A large percentage of lines are busy during the business hours of the day, to which is due the frequent reply by operators that "line is busy." Subscribers should understand and appreciate the fact that it is no more work, and much more agreeable, for an operator to ring the number called for than to say "line is busy" or "they don't answer" unless such is the fact.

In calling for a number, give the figures separately, thus: 125 say "one-two-five" making special effort to *speak distinctly, and with the mouth close to the transmitter*. After receiving the number the operator will *always* ring. If you do not receive an answer she will gladly ring them again for you on request. If you receive no answer don't blame the operator; ringing is the easiest thing she can do.

Always answer your telephone promptly if you expect good service. In answering, it is much better to give your name or the firm name instead of the "hello." This will be a time saver if practiced. Try it.

Do not expect an operator to always remember what number called you. Operators handle thousands of calls daily, and during the rush hours little thought is given to just who calls.

Subscribers are cordially invited to visit the Exchange. It will help to give you a correct idea of the telephone and the work of operator.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Ring off when through talking.

**TELEPHONES ARE RENTED BY THE YEAR AND ARE PAYABLE MONTHLY IN ADVANCE**

Do not use instruments during thunder storms.

For time of trains ask Central.

Report fires direct to Central, giving location.

Central office closed Sundays and Holidays from 10 30 a. m. to 3 30 p. m.

Toll line charges are for five minutes conversation; when lines are held longer additional charges are checked up against us, and we have no alternative but to collect it.

Subscribers will be held responsible for any damage to instruments outside of ordinary wear incident to careful use.

Get list of new subscribers from operator and correct your Directory.

Report any difficulty or irregularity in service to the Manager. We require civility and attention on the part of the operators, and any deviation from this should be promptly reported.

Do not take up the time of the operators at Central with unnecessary conversation. The operator has duties to perform.

Our country lines are free to subscribers only. A fee of 10 cents will be charged all non-subscribers for the use of these lines. **Do not talk for or allow your Telephone to be used thus without collecting this Toll**, as it will be charged to your telephone.

Country lines should not be used longer than *five* minutes at a time, as there are other people on that line who want to talk.

A charge of one dollar is made for changing a telephone from one part of a town to another, or for changing to a different part of the town. In changing telephones, the subscriber will furnish transportation for man in

their exclusive use. The continued use of these lines by non-subscribers is a nuisance to our paying subscribers, and is strictly forbidden. Such persons to this rule.
